THE JOSEPH S. COPPOCK, JR. SCHOLARSHIP

The Joseph S. Coppock, Jr. Scholarship was established by the Alachua-Central District Lay Organization of the East Conference in support of the pursuit of academic excellence. Scholarships are being offered to individuals who are seeking assistance in furthering their education. The funds for this scholarship will be administered by the Alachua-Central District Lay Organization of the African Methodist Episcopal Church.

PURPOSE OF THIS SCHOLARSHIP

- To recognize and reward the educational excellence of high school graduates planning to attend and/or college students who currently attend an accredited post-secondary institution.
- To encourage young people to be actively involved in the Lay Organization of the AME Church.

CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY

- Applicants must be a member of the African Methodist Episcopal Church.
- Applicants must be either a 2025 high school graduate from a public or private school or currently enrolled in an accredited institution of higher learning with a GPA of at least 2.5.

SELECTION PROCESS

Recipients will be selected by a judging committee comprised of members of the Alachua-Central District Lay Organization. The committee will evaluate eligible students based on their academic record, financial need, and quality of the essay, reference letters, extracurricular activities and accomplishments. Winners will be announced by the Scholarship Committee at the site of the Annual Convention. All decisions by the committee are final. No material will be returned. **Applications not submitted in their entirety will not be processed.**

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Completed application (must be typed)
- A current official High School transcript of grades in a sealed school envelope. If college sophomore or higher, applicant must send the committee an official transcript from the college of the school attending. **(Official transcripts may be scanned as a pdf if the seal appears on the transcript).**
- Applicants must submit an essay (300-500 words) that entails the below four elements. The essay must be double-spaced and typed or word processed.
 - (1) Your long-range goals
 - (2) Community and Church involvement
 - (3) Challenges you have faced
 - (4) How you responded to your challenges****(NOTE: Essay should include all four elements)**
- A minimum of two (2) letters of recommendation (one letter must be from a school official who is familiar with the student's academic performance and potential). Letters may include pastors, local lay presidents, church school teachers, high school teachers, etc. **(Letters from relatives are not acceptable)**
- Two (2) photographs, business attire
- A Letter of Acceptance from the school attending. (High School Graduates)
- All materials must be submitted to the **Local Lay President** by the deadline to be considered. Direct all questions to the email address alachuacentraldistrictlay@gmail.com.
